To get from Form 1 to Form 2. (third person past to first person present)

Step 1. Add prefix in, and

$\text{in}pV > \text{imp}V$, $\text{in}p' > \text{imp}'$

$\text{in}kV > \text{ing}V$, $\text{in}k' > \text{ink}'$

$\text{in}tV > \text{ind}V$, ...

$\text{in}V > \text{in}V$, everything else just add in- in front

Step 2. Case 1: If the ending is $C'Vy$, then $C'Vy > C'V$

Case 2: If the ending is V_1CV_2y' , then $> V_1C^*V_2$

Case 3: If the ending is C_1C_2Vy' , then $> C_1V^*C_2^*V_1$

where C_i^* is the same as C_i except:

$C_i = \zeta$, then $C_i^* = ts$

$C_i = d$, then $C_i^* = t$

and V^* is a unless all vowels in Form 1 are the same, being V_0 .

then $V^* = V_0$.

Clarification: Normal stem change from Form 1 is

$$C_1 C_2 V_1 y' \rightarrow C_1 V^* C_2' V_1$$

$$\text{or } C_1 C_2 V_1 ? \rightarrow C_1 V^* C_2' V_1 ?$$

with the same V^* and C_i' rules as for Form 1 to Form 2.

Double vowel change is, from Form 2

$$C_1 V_1 C_2 V_2 (C) \rightarrow C_1 V_1 V_1 C_2 V_2 (C), \text{ regardless of '}$$

Straight from Form 1 means that the verbs doesn't undergo the above two changes.

All the changes below are from Form 1
